- 2. Please ensure to specify one sub-discipline category that is most suitable for your manuscript at top left hand corner of the first page of the manuscript from the following: Engineering and Technology; Agriculture; Pure and Applied Sciences; Computer and Information Sciences. You should also indicate whether your manuscript is a research article or review article (e.g., Sub-discipline Category: Engineering & Technology, Research Article; or Pure & Applied Sciences, Review Article).
- 3. Title of the manuscript should be brief containing a maximum of 21 words.
- 4. There should be a short running title of not more than 10 words that will run across every page of the manuscript.
- 5. Authors' full names (first-name, middle-name, and last-name), affiliations (Department and Institution) and functional email address of all authors should then follow. One of the authors should be assigned as the corresponding author.
- 6. Research article or review article should be 3,500-8,000 words, accompanied by an abstract of 150-200 words and 5 keywords.
- 7. Manuscript should be typewritten in Microsoft Word, with Times New Roman font, size 12, double line spacing and normal margin (1 inch all sides).
- 8. Headings and sub-headings of different sections should be clearly defined and consecutively numbered with Arabic numerals.
- 9. Tables and figures when used must be cited in the text and placed as close as possible to where they are cited and not separate at the back of the entire manuscript. Tables and figures are numbered consecutively throughout the text but independent from each other. Every table and figure should have a caption. A table caption is centred above the table; a figure caption is centred under the figure.
- 10. For enumeration and measurement, use numerals whenever a number is followed by a standard unit of measurement e.g. 2 g, 7 days; otherwise, use words for one through to nine and numerals for larger numbers. Report all data in metric unit and provide at least one measure of variability (e.g. standard

- error or standard deviation) when reporting quantitative data. Abbreviations of any term should be spelled out in full at first mention.
- 11. The text should adhere to the citation and referencing style of the American Psychological Association (APA), 7<sup>th</sup> edition.
- 12. The Journal uses double blind review process in which the process of reviewing manuscript is based on the anonymity of the author and the confidentiality of reviewers;
- 13. The Editorial Board reserves the right to edit a manuscript to make it more readable.
